THIS YEAR'S RECIPIENT FOR THE CAR SHOW: JACE MOONEY.

Jace is a 16-month-old boy who was born with Fibular Hemimelia, which is a rare deformity that occurs in 1 in every 100,000- 150,000 births. He does not have the fibula bone in his left leg and his ankle is turned sideways. He will probably have to have 3 - 4 surgeries to lengthen his leg, which will require trips to a specialist in Florida. He is facing a "super ankle" surgery before his first leg-lengthening surgery. The family will have to relocate to Florida for several months while this is going on. This will require housing for them and/or trips back and forth. All donations will go directly to Jace and his family to cover the cost of medical and travel expenses. Part of the \$3 registrations and the 50/50 collected at the cruises this summer will go to this family.
